










A Word From Our Artistic Managing Director...



Welcome to the gothic masterpiece *Jekyll & Hyde the Musical*, the 1990 musical loosely based on the 1886 novella *The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde* by Robert Louis Stevenson. Originally conceived for the stage by Frank Wildhorn and Steve Cuden, it features music by Frank Wildhorn, book by Leslie Bricusse and lyrics by all of them.

After a world premiere run in Houston, TX, it embarked on a national tour of the US prior to its 1997 Broadway debut. Many international productions in various languages have since been staged including two subsequent North American tours, two tours in the UK, a concert version, a revamped 2012 US tour, 2013 Broadway revival and a 2019 Australian concert version.

The show was first presented at the Alley Theatre in Houston, TX, in May 1990 where it broke box office records, played to sold-out houses, and won acclaim from critics leading to the run being extended twice, finally closing in July 1990. After an almost three-year hiatus, the show returned to Houston, produced by Theatre Under the Stars. It ran from January 20, to February 19, 1995, for a limited engagement. It then played the 5th Ave Theatre in Seattle from February 28 to March 19, 1995. Due to the success of both runs, the musical embarked on a national tour of the US on August 1, 1995 The musical premiered on Broadway at the Plymouth Theatre (now the Gerald Schoenfeld Theatre) on March 21, 1997 (previews), officially on April 28. The musical played an almost-four-year run and became the longest-running show in the history of the Plymouth Theatre, closing after 1,543 regular performances on January 7, 2001. The show was also nominated for 4 Tony Awards and won two Drama Desk Award, a Theatre World Award and an Outer Critics Circle Award.

So sit back and enjoy this dark tale of a man torn between the good and evil sides of his nature . What evil lurks in the hearts of men? Tonight you just might find out.....
